Plastic products will also be collected as recyclable plastic resources from April to make good use of limited resources. We kindly request your cooperation in sorting your garbage.

How to dispose of recyclable plastic resources:

Garbage bags: Use *the bag for plastic containers and packages* printed in green, which you are presently using. Notes: New *bags for recyclable plastic resources* will become available from around July 2024. You can continue using the present garbage bags even after the new bags become available.

Disposal day: Dispose of recyclable plastic resources on Wednesday as usual. Recyclable plastic resources will be collected from April 3 (Wed), 2024.

Disposal time: Dispose of them at the designated collection points by 8:30 a.m. as usual.

Types of plastic products: Items which are entirely or mostly made of plastic such as wash-basins, toothbrushes and hangers

More items will be collected in addition to items with the recyclable plastic mark from April 2024.

Advantages of using My Number Cards as health insurance cards

- 1 You can receive better medical care founded on data.
 - With your consent, information on prescribed medications and health checkup results from the past can be shared with your doctors and pharmacists enabling you to receive better medical care.
- ② You do not need to take any procedures to become exempt for paying more than the ceiling-amount for high-cost medical care.

Registration is needed to use My Number Cards as health insurance cards.

[How to register]

- ① Get your My Number Card issued
- If you have lost your "Individual Number Card application form," you can have it reissued at the Resident Services Div.
- ② Register your My Number Card as a health insurance card
- You can register on the "Mynaportal" site via your personal computer or smart phone, at ATMs of Seven Bank, and at the window of the City Hall on the first floor.

Though costs for school lunches have risen due to surging prices, Nisshin City will cover and support the shortage and will not raise school lunch fees paid by parents. This measure will be applied for lunches provided at public nursery schools and private childcare facilities as well as for those at elementary and junior high schools in Nisshin.

2 Distribution of electronic gifts to subsidize the purchase of nursery items and school supplies

Nisshin City will distribute electronic gifts to households raising babies and infants aged 0 to 2 and high school students to subsidize the purchase of nursery items and school supplies.

[Eligibility] Persons raising children registered in Nisshin as of April 1, 2024 and fulfill either of the following requirements:

(1) Children born between April 2, 2021 and April 1, 2024

(2) Children born between April 2, 2006 and April 1, 2009

[Allowance] Electronic gift worth 10,000 yen per eligible child

[Application] No application is required. A guidebook for receipt of the gift will be sent to eligible households. Details including when distribution will start will be posted on the Nisshin City website as soon as they are decided.

③ Transportation IC cards will be distributed to senior citizens aged 75 and older

[Allowance] (1) Certified farmers: 100,000 yen per person (2) Other farmers: 20,000 yen per house [Necessary documents]

Priority Support Benefits for rising prices are provided to residential tax-exempt households and households who paid residential tax only on the per capita basis in fiscal 2023. Of these households, those raising children will receive additional benefits of 50,000 yen for each child aged 18 and younger.

"Notice of provision" or "Note for confirmation" is being sent by mail to these households.
