The census is a very important statistical survey conducted once every five years throughout Japan. Collected data on population and living conditions is used to make policies to improve and develop schools, welfare and the city.

How to respond to the census

Answer on your own

- 1) We recommend you respond by using your smartphone or PC. It takes about 15 minutes. Answer via the QR code in the questionnaire.
- 2) Send your completed response form by post from October 1 (Wed) to October 8 (Wed). If you wish to return your response form to the census taker, ask him/her about it when he/she visits your home.

Questions & Answers

1) Q: Will a census taker come to my house?

A: Yes. A census taker will bring the census documents to your house. All households living in Nisshin City must answer the census. If you are not at home, the questionnaire will be put in your postbox.

2) Q: Must we answer the survey form?

A: Yes. The Statistics Act requires that all people living in Japan respond to the census. Thank you for your cooperation.

3) Problems: I lost the survey form.

I haven't received the survey form.

A: In these cases, please contact the Nisshin City Reception Center.

Census takers never ask for your bank account PINs or credit card numbers. If you feel suspicious, please consult the Nisshin City Census Reception Center about it.

1. From October 1 (Wed) 2025

Distribution of application documents begins (on the website and at the Nisshin City Hall).

2. Mid-October to early November 2025

Application period

Details on the application method and period will be posted on the Nisshin City website on October 1 (Wed) 2025.

3. The end of December 2025

Results will be notified.

4. Mid-February to March 2026

Briefing sessions for entrance preparations, pre-entry medical checkups and other procedures will be carried out.

Questions and Answers for people who don't know how to choose a nursery school

1) Q: How should I choose a nursery school?

A: Many people take into consideration the contents of childcare, hours children are kept, commuting route, and workplace location. Priorities differ depending on your home conditions and way of thinking.

We recommend you to visit facilities that seem to meet your conditions and check for yourself.

2) Q: Are there any useful references?

A: In the Nisshin City website, we have compiled "A Guide to Childcare and Educational facilities in Nisshin" in which contents of childcare and features of facilities in Nisshin City are introduced, and schedule for when facilities and school yards are open for tours and visits. You can also check out the websites of each nursery school as well as "Ten points to choose a suitable nursery school" introduced on the Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare website. Please make use of them.
