Sports Facilities in Nisshin

(にっしん×スポーツ)

1. AGU Sports Center in Aichi Gakuin University

Citizens of Nisshin City can use the heated swimming pool and training facility at the university's AGU Sports Center for a fee.

2. Aichi Korogi Sports Park

Aichi Korogi Sports Park managed by the Aichi Prefectural Government has tennis courts and a soccer field which is also used for rugby. The 50-meter swimming pool is one of the four all-season indoor swimming pools in Aichi Prefecture.

3. Jonoike Sports Park

Jonoike Sports Park has tennis courts, sports fields and a field with athletic equipment.

4. Nisshin City Sports Center

The sports center has a training room, multi-purpose halls for various sports, and a hall with *tatami* mats for martial arts.

5. Aichi Ike (Aichi Pond)

Aichi Ike or Aichi Pond is a regulating reservoir managed by Aichi Yosui (Aichi Irrigation Public Corporation). Regattas and boat lessons are held here. The trail around the reservoir is excellent for walking and serves as a venue for *Ekiden* road relays.

6. Nisshin City General Athletic Park

The athletic park is an excellent facility to enjoy a wide range of sports and jogging in autumn. People enjoy fishing at its swimming pool from winter to spring.
